2 MONTHS	Pentacel (Diphtheria /Tetanus /Acellular Pertussis-Hemophilus Influenza B- Inactivated Polio) #1 Prevnar 13 (Pneumococcus) #1 Rotateq (oral rotavirus) #1
4 MONTHS	Pentacel (Diphtheria /Tetanus /Acellular Pertussis-Hemophilus Influenza B- Inactivated Polio) #2 Prevnar 13 (Pneumococcus) #2 Rotateq (oral rotavirus) #2
6 MONTHS	Pentacel (Diphtheria /Tetanus /Acellular Pertussis-Hemophilus Influenza B- Inactivated Polio) #3 Prevnar 13 (Pneumococcus) #3 Rotateq (oral rotavirus) #3 Hepatitis B #3
12 MONTHS	Hepatitis A #1 Prevnar 13 (Pneumococcus) #4 MMR (Measles / Mumps / Rubella) #1
15 MONTHS	Pentacel (Diphtheria /Tetanus /Acellular Pertussis-Hemophilus Influenza B- Inactivated Polio) #4 Varicella (chicken pox) #1
18 MONTHS	Hepatitis A #2 (Must be given at least 6 months after #1)
2 YEARS	Hepatitis A #2 (if not given at 18 mos)
4 - 5 YEARS	DTaP (Diphtheria /Tetanus /Acellular Pertussis) #5 IPV (Inactivated Polio) #4 MMR (Measles / Mumps / Rubella) #2 Varicella (chicken pox) #2
6 mos & older	Influenza vaccine every fall/winter
